



# SUMMER AT STANLEY

## Day Camp

For students entering grades K-2  
7 weeks of full day sessions (8:30 am-3:00 pm)

Join us for a fun-filled summer on the beautiful 11-acre campus of Stanley British Primary School. Each one-week session offers opportunities in visual and performing arts, science, sports, swimming and choice time. A different theme is integrated each week through a variety of activities. Classes are taught by a talented team of Stanley BPS teachers and interns. For the 2021 summer, students will be in cohorts of no more than 15 campers and will stay with their cohort for the entire week.

The Day Camp is designed to meet a wide variety of interests. Our teachers work hard to provide stimulating, age appropriate, hands-on activities. Students have an opportunity to explore new endeavors in a safe, supportive environment while having loads of fun! For the 2021 summer, students will remain in the same classroom space for the full day with the same teachers and students.

### **Fees:**

Program fees include the classes and a t-shirt.

## **Registration:**

Once you have completed your online registration, you will receive a confirmation via email that your order was received. You will have the option to pay for camp in full or pay a \$50 non-refundable deposit per camp. If you need to make changes to your camp order, see the policy on the Stanley British Primary School website.

The full balance of tuition is due by May 1. If a credit card was used for the deposit, and we have not received an alternate form of payment prior to May 1, we will charge the balance to that card. After May 1, there are no refunds issued (unless we cancel camp).

## **2021 Day Camp Session Descriptions**

### **Session 1: June 7 - June 11**

#### **Weekly Theme: Seasons**

We'll spend this week exploring nature and learning about our 4 seasons! We'll celebrate each season with it's own special project and learn all about trees and why they change with the seasons. We'll learn about some of our garden friends, including butterflies, ladybugs and caterpillars and explore different ways to create delicious dishes with vegetables harvested from the garden. Children will also get a chance to practice weather science and create some fun and unique yard art.

### **Session 2: June 14 - June 18**

#### **Weekly Theme: Wild Animals**

Who doesn't love learning more about animals? In this session campers will get to create their own 2D and 3D wild animals in art, and create crafts using their own hands and feet! We'll also have opportunities to observe wild animals like rabbits and birds around Stanley and learn to move like the animals through books, yoga poses, and improvisations. Campers will get to hop on Ms. Frizzle's Magic School Bus to learn about the dinosaurs that roamed our earth and learn to cook snacks from our favorite animal books.

### **Session 3: June 21 - June 25**

#### **Weekly Theme: Superheroes**

This week we'll all have a chance to release our inner superheroes! We'll tie-dye our own superhero capes, practice our best superhero moves, solve some superpower puzzles, and investigate some scientific wonders. Campers will also get the chance to learn about superpower foods, cook with superpowers, and learn about different everyday heroes, including getting the chance to design their own hero.

## **Session 4: June 28 - July 2**

### **Weekly Theme: Gross-ology**

Session 4 is about every gross thing your kids love! They'll create yucky crafts, make all kinds of bug-themed treats to eat and play with all the oobleck and slime they can imagine. They will also get to learn about gross aspects of the human body, including everyday injuries and how to properly care for them. If it's gross, you'll find it here!

## **Session 5: July 12-16**

### **Weekly Theme: Outer Space**

Is your child obsessed with all things space? In this session campers will be hands-on and engaged in creating our solar system, making bottle rockets, and discovering the powers of the moon. We'll create astronaut and alien themed crafts, make planetary systems and explore intergalactic cooking.

## **Session 6: July 19-23**

### **Weekly Theme: Magic and Mysteries**

Abacadabra! Session 6 explores all things magical. From exploring the wonders of Harry Potter and getting to play quidditch to cooking and baking chemistry, campers are going to have a magical week! Campers can create magical fairy gardens, solve puzzles and brain teasers, and explore their own magical alter-egos.

## **Session 7: July 26-30**

### **Weekly Theme: Creative Creatures**

There are so many opportunities this week to learn about different creatures. Campers can create their own wacky create in imagination station, they can learn about some of the world's most unusual animals, and they can cook treats for their favorite animals and themselves! Through books, games, crafts and so much more, campers will have a blast learning about their favorite creatures.
