Day Camp

For students entering grades K-2
6 weeks of full day sessions (8:30 am-3:00 pm)

Join us for a fun-filled summer on the beautiful 11-acre campus of Stanley British Primary School. Each one-week session offers opportunities in visual and performing arts, science, sports, swimming and choice time. A different theme is integrated each week through a variety of activities. Classes are taught by a talented team of Stanley BPS teachers and teaching fellows.

The Day Camp is designed to meet a wide variety of interests. Our teachers work hard to provide stimulating, age appropriate, hands-on activities. Students have an opportunity to explore new endeavors in a safe, supportive environment while having loads of fun!

Fees:

Program fees include the classes and all materials (minus swim lessons).

Registration:

Once you have completed your online registration, you will receive a confirmation via email that your order was received. You will have the option to pay for your camps in full on the day of registration or pay a \$75 non-refundable deposit per camp, and the rest of camp tuition is due by April 1. If you need to make changes to your camp order, see the policy on the Stanley British Primary School website.

The full balance of tuition is due by April 1. If a credit card was used for the deposit, and we have not received an alternate form of payment prior to April 1, we will charge the balance to that card. After April 1, there are no refunds issued (unless we cancel camp).

2024 Day Camp Session Descriptions

Session 1: June 3 - June 7

Weekly Theme: Around the World

Oh, the places you'll go! Explore the world from your classroom at Summer at Stanley. You'll have the chance to experience the sights, sounds and tastes from cultures near and far. You'll also learn a bit about the geography of our world as we venture to various countries. Get your adventurous spirit ready!

Session 2: June 10 - June 14

Weekly Theme: Wild Animals and Creative Creatures

Who doesn't love learning more about animals and creatures? In this session campers will get to create their own 2D and 3D wild animals in art and create crafts using their own hands and feet! We'll also have opportunities to observe wild animals like rabbits and birds around Stanley and learn to move like the animals through books, yoga poses, and improvisations. Campers will get to hop on Ms. Frizzle's Magic School Bus to learn about the dinosaurs and other creatures that roamed our earth and learn to cook treats for their favorite animals and themselves!

Session 3: June 17- June 21 *Please note this is a 4-day week in honor of Juneteenth Federal Holiday-prorated tuition. There will be NO camp on Wednesday.*

Weekly Theme: Superheroes

This week we'll all have a chance to release our inner superheroes! We'll tie-dye our own superhero capes, practice our best superhero moves, solve some superpower puzzles, and investigate some scientific wonders. Campers will also get the chance to learn about superpower foods, cook with superpowers, and learn about different everyday heroes, including getting the chance to design their own hero.

Session 4: June 24 - June 28

Weekly Theme: Gross-ology

Session 4 is about every gross thing your kids love! They'll create yucky crafts, make all kinds of bug-themed treats to eat and play with all the oobleck and slime they can imagine. They will also get to learn about gross aspects of the human body, including everyday injuries and how to properly care for them. If it's gross, you'll find it here!

Session 5: July 8-12

Weekly Theme: Outer Space

Is your child obsessed with all things space? In this session campers will be hands-on and engaged in creating our solar system, making bottle rockets, and discovering the powers of the moon. We'll create astronaut and alien themed crafts, make planetary systems and explore intergalactic cooking.

Session 6: July 15-19

Weekly Theme: Magic and Mysteries

Abracadabra! Session 6 explores all things magical. From exploring the wonders of Harry Potter and getting to play a variation of quidditch to cooking and baking chemistry, campers are going to have a magical week! Campers can create magical fairy gardens, solve puzzles and brain teasers, and explore their own magical alter-egos.
