



SUMMER AT STANLEY

Specialty Camps

For students entering grades 3rd - 8th

Join us for a fun-filled summer on the beautiful 11-acre campus of Stanley British Primary School. The specialty programs are for older children who can handle longer classes and more intensive experiences. Students participate in the area of endeavor for the entire week. Classes are taught by a talented team of Stanley BPS teachers and professionals.

Our specialty camps are designed to meet a wide variety of interests. Our teachers work hard to provide stimulating, age appropriate, hands-on activities. Students have an opportunity to explore new endeavors in a safe, supportive environment while having loads of fun! For the 2024 summer, students will remain in the same classroom space for the full day with the same students.

Fees:

Full Day - \$440 per week + materials fee + one-time \$25 registration fee

(Session 3 is a 4-day week; tuition is prorated to \$352.)

Hogwarts - \$460 per week + materials fee + one-time \$25 registration fee

Early Birds (7:30-8:30 AM) - \$50 per week

Once you have completed your online registration, you will receive a confirmation via email that your order was received. You will have the option to pay for camp in full or pay a \$75 non-refundable deposit per camp. If you need to make changes to your camp order, see the policy on the Stanley British Primary School website.

The full balance of tuition is due by April 1. If a credit card was used for the deposit, and we have not received an alternate form of payment prior to April 1, we will charge the balance to that card. After April 1, there are no refunds issued (unless we cancel camp).

You also have the option to buy insurance, which is 10% of your total registration. If you choose to withdraw for any reason and have purchased insurance, you will be refunded 100% of your tuition. If Stanley must cancel camp for any reason, you will be refunded your tuition minus the \$25 registration fee to help offset the cost.
