



SUMMER AT STANLEY

Specialty Camp

For students entering grades 3rd - 8th
7 weeks of full day sessions (8:30 am-3:00 pm)

Join us for a fun-filled summer on the beautiful 11-acre campus of Stanley British Primary School. The specialty programs are for older children who are able to handle longer classes and more intensive experiences. Students participate in the area of endeavor for the entire week(s). Classes are taught by a talented team of Stanley BPS teachers and professionals. For the 2021 summer, students will be in cohorts of 20 campers and will stay with their cohort for the entire week.

Our specialty camps are designed to meet a wide variety of interests. Our teachers work hard to provide stimulating, age appropriate, hands-on activities. Students have an opportunity to explore new endeavors in a safe, supportive environment while having loads of fun! For the 2021 summer, students will remain in the same classroom space for the full day with the same students.

Fees:

Full Day - \$400 per week + materials + one-time \$25 registration fee

Hogwarts - \$435 per week + materials + one-time \$25 registration fee

Registration:

Once you have completed your online registration, you will receive a confirmation via email that your order was received. You will have the option to pay for camp in full or pay a \$50 non-refundable deposit per camp. If you need to make changes to your camp order, see the policy on the Stanley British Primary School website.

The full balance of tuition is due by May 1. If a credit card was used for the deposit, and we have not received an alternate form of payment prior to May 1, we will charge the balance to that card. After May 1, there are no refunds issued (unless we cancel camp).

You have the option to buy insurance for 2021, which is 10% of your total registration. If you choose to withdraw for any reason and have purchased insurance, you will be refunded 100% of your tuition. If Stanley has to cancel camp for any reason, you will be refunded your tuition minus the \$25 registration fee to help offset the cost.

Kids learn to code by creating their own video games. Each camper works with a laptop and with Scratch, an MIT-developed computer programming language for young people. Participants begin by learning the basic concepts behind classic games like Pong, Pac-Man, and Super Mario Bros. Then they invent new games of their own. MindDance teachers provide inspiration and support as kids create and share their work. Participants experience a warm and social learning community that is hands-on, challenging, and fun. The Scratch programming language is free and web-based, allowing campers to work on their projects from home, long after camp is over, and to publish their work to the Scratch website. The camp is great for beginning and experienced coders.
